RE: GHS Conversion Update


New changes to the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Hazard Communication Standard are bringing the United States into alignment with the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and the Labeling of Chemicals (GHS). These changes will affect the product labels and the Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDSs), which will now be known as Safety Data Sheets (SDSs).

The new GHS standard still requires that the labels and SDSs contain most of the same safety information, but now provides a single set of harmonized criteria for classifying chemicals according to their health and physical hazards. The new product labels will have the following mandated criteria clearly stated – product identifier, signal word, pictogram(s), hazard statements, supplier identification and precautionary statements.

ITW Polymers Adhesives North America has been diligently working with our vendors and third party providers, receiving pertinent information and preparing the product labels and SDSs in the forms required to meet the new standard. We anticipate completion of the GHS conversion for the Devcon, Plexus, and SprayCore brand products before the end of July 2015. Upon completion, ITW Polymers Adhesives will immediately update relevant product labeling and SDS product information on our website www.itwadhesives.com.
